Looking after your health whilst travelling is important and includes taking any necessary precautions against certain health risks that are more likely when travelling abroad.

Travel immunisations

If you're planning on travelling outside of the UK, you may need to be vaccinated against some of the serious diseases found in other parts of the world. You should give at least 8 weeks' notice to your GP or travel clinic prior to your departure. Some vaccines need to be given in advance to allow your body to develop immunity and some vaccines involve several doses spread over weeks or months.

Air Travel

To reduce the risk of deep vein thrombosis, it is sensible for anyone on a long-haul flight to exercise your legs, feet and toes whilst sitting and take short walks whenever feasible. Flight socks may be worn.

Insect Bites

Insect bites and stings are not usually serious and get better in a few days. But sometimes they can become infected and cause a serious allergic reaction. The main symptoms of an insect bite or sting are:

- pain where you were bitten or stung
- a small, swollen lump on the skin

You can often treat an insect bite or sting by visiting a pharmacy, without seeing a GP.

Always wash your skin with soap and water to help lower the chance of infection. The

bite or sting should get better in a few days. If the symptoms become worse or does not get better contact your GP.
